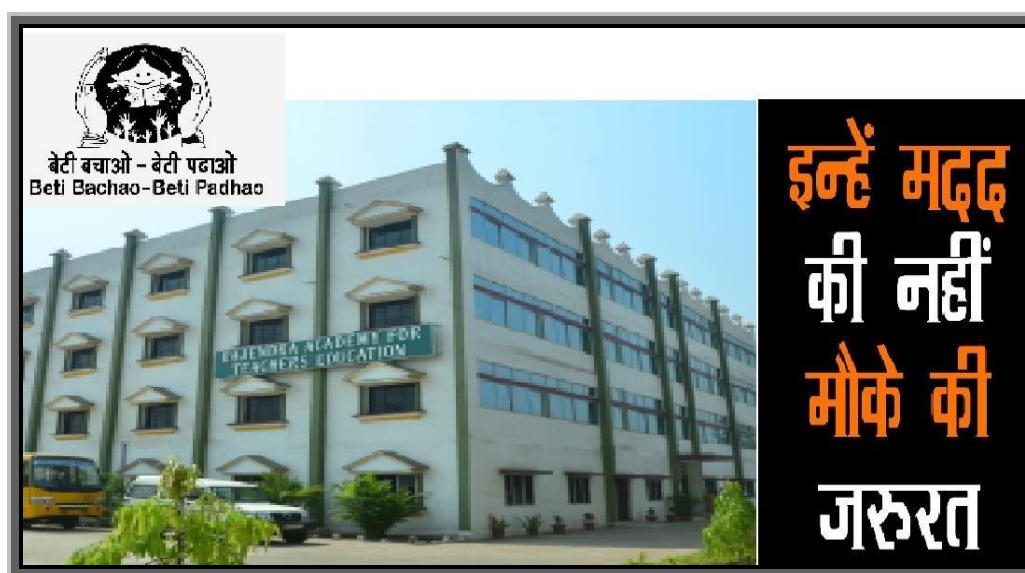

BBBP mission emphasizes on safeguarding and strengthening the rights of women. People are becoming more sensitized and several girls of India are bringing accolades to the nation and becoming popular on International level. Thus, people should stop discriminating between the girl and the boy child and support both the genders equally. This programme is to remove the social biases favoring the male child in society as well as improving the status of girl child through safety and education. This scheme is not a medicine curing a disease however it is a supportive plan. It can be successful only when it will be supported by us.

There is need to change the attitude and mindset especially in the minds of the parents towards the girl child forever so that she too can get the same opportunity after her birth like safety, health care, education, etc. In this way, a girl child can be an independent entity and not a burden over her parents. I would like to share with you a nice line written by me regarding girl child: "Make a girl child power of the family, society and country; and not a burden, weakness and helpless entity of the family, society and country" Beti Bachao Beti Padhao" (BBBP) campaign was basically started to promote the safety of girl child.

There are several people who still discriminate between a girl and a boy child. But the fact is that a girl child is no less than a boy. In the present times, girls in fact are bringing a lot of accolades to its family and nation as a whole in every field including sports, politics, entertainment, corporate world, wrestling, etc. But people still have that old school mentality that girls are rather a liability and thus, various people started getting sex of the child determined before its birth and aborting the girl child in the womb itself.

In order to make the mission BBBP successful, we must first teach the existing girls how to be strong and self-willed and more importantly determined in order to take decisions of their own lives.



Programme in Details



The programme started with the inaugural introduction from Dr. Madhumita Baidya, Associate Professor of Rajendra Academy for Teachers' Education. She has been very graceful towards the organization and innovative arrangement of the online initiative of Rajendra Academy. She expressed her gratitude to the Founder of the College Shri Jayanta Kumar Chakrabarty for giving the college and the staff the full-fledged opportunity to celebrate each day with the mark of excellence.

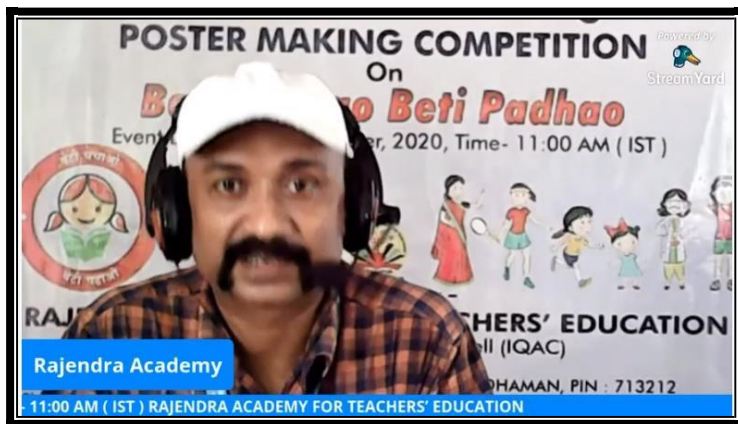
She also said that the principal in Chair Prof. (Dr.) Baishnab Charan Swain had been quite collaborative and helpful towards the college so that the college activities could get the scope to flourish with integrity, power and elegance.

Dr. Baidya finds herself all in pink while she describes the importance of a girl in the society. She feels that where there are no women there is no man and there is no society. 'Beti Bachao Beti Padhao,' (Save the girl child, educate girl child) is a personal campaign by the Indian government. It aims to generate awareness to improve the efficiency of welfare services meant for girls.



She further added with the introductory speech some important and legal information which is by law some of the important and significant in all terms and conditions. She had focused upon the importance of the girls and their presence in the family, and society on a bigger part. This adds meaning to the existence where there is no killing of the female fetus should be encouraged. The Union Government will organize a three-state field-level campaign on Beti Bachao Beti Padhao (BBBP) in the first week of January 2019.

Beti Bachao Beti Padhao was launched on January 22, 2015 by Prime Minister Narendra Modi. This scheme aims to promote gender equality and emphasizes on the significance of educating girls. The scheme was initially launched with an initial funding of Rs. 100 crore and targets clusters in Haryana, Uttar Pradesh, Punjab, Bihar, Uttarakhand and Delhi.



The next speaker for the online programme was Prof. (Dr.) Baishnab Charan Swain, Principal, Rajendra Academy for Teachers' Education. He spotlighted on various spheres of Beti Bachao Beti Padhao. This programme aimed to address the declining child sex ratio image (CSR). It is a national initiative and tri-ministerial effort by the Ministry of Women and Child Development, the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare and the Ministry of Human Resource Development.



It was initially introduced in 100 districts throughout the country possessing low child-sex ratio. In addition, the scheme intends to improve the same through multi-sectoral interventions, which includes prevention of gender-biased sex selection and promoting girls' education and her holistic empowerment. Child-Sex ratio may be defined as the number of girls per 1000 boys aged between 0-6 years. This ratio reflects both pre-birth and post-birth discrimination towards girls, manifested through gender-biased sex selection. However, a decline in CSR is a major indicator of women disempowerment.

Girl children in different parts of India are not allowed to go to schools beyond primary classes, and some of them are not allowed to go to even primary classes. They are dispossessed of all the privileges that their brothers enjoy. It is terrifying to know that girl children get killed in their mother's womb even before their birth in some parts of India.

Due to this reason, girls of our country suffer a lot and various issues like eve-teasing, physical assault, dowry, and sexual assaults. So, the question arises here is, are we actually living in a developed society where our partners of the female sex in their life are suffering like animals and even worse? The answer is undoubtedly going to be a "no."



The honorary Academic Director, Shri Dr. Dharendra Kumar Mohapatra had been more expressive about the best initiatives that Rajendra Academy took to organize the online campaign and he focused upon the benefits of the Scheme along with the campaigns. He speaks and separates the different topics upon the various features.

Achievements and Benefits of Beti Bachao Beti Padhao

- It aims at making girls independent, both monetarily and socially.
- Through Beti Bachao Beti Padhao, the government aims to generate awareness towards women issues.
- The government also wishes to improve the efficiency of delivery of welfare services meant for women.
- The government has launched '*Sukanya Samridhi Yojana*' for the benefit of Girl child. This scheme carries the highest interest, 8.1% interest rate per annum. Parents of girl child aged between 2-10 years can open this account in the Post Office, with the maximum deposit limit being Rs. 1.50 lakhs per annum.
- The impact of Beti Bachao Beti Padhao scheme is visible in only 2 years from its launch date. However, the sex ratio has reportedly crossed up to 950 females per 1000 males.
- The number of women police officers has also increased from 6% to 8.5%.
- A large number of women are now free to join fields and careers of their own choices. These careers ranging from armed forces, science, journalism, sports, wrestling, engineering among others.
- The government is continually stressing on quality education for girls and encouraging parents to send their girl child to school.

Hurdles in implementing Beti Bachao Beti Padhao

Despite the key changes brought about by Beti Bachao Beti Padhao scheme, it will be difficult for it to gain momentum unless properly executed.

- Social abuses and orthodox rituals like female foeticide, Sati, child marriage and domestic abuse hinder the due implementation of this scheme.
- The government machinery and the police is yet to comprehend the magnitude of women atrocities seriously. This also weakens the effective implementation of Beti Bachao Beti Padhao scheme.
- Moreover, the mindset of people remains conservative as ever despite numerous campaigns spreading awareness among people.
- The scheme needs a civic body support to achieve the objectives of the scheme.
- The Dowry system is of the major obstacles in the successful implementation and impact of Beti Bachao Beti Padhao scheme.



Various participants from all corners were participating to make the programme all the more interesting. The online notice was lead out to give the best and possible outcome.

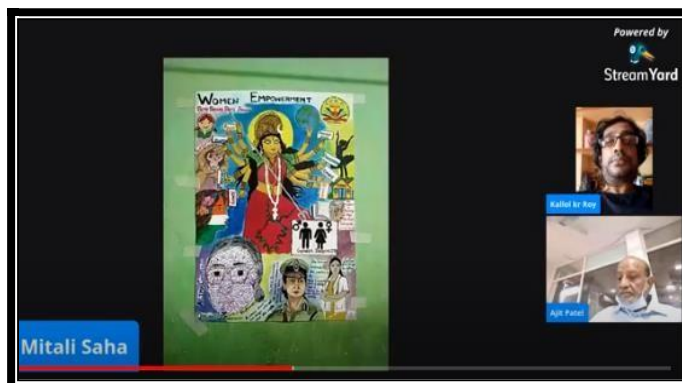
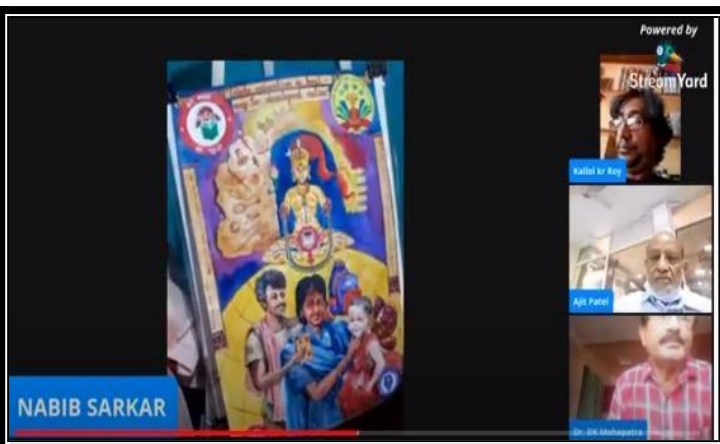
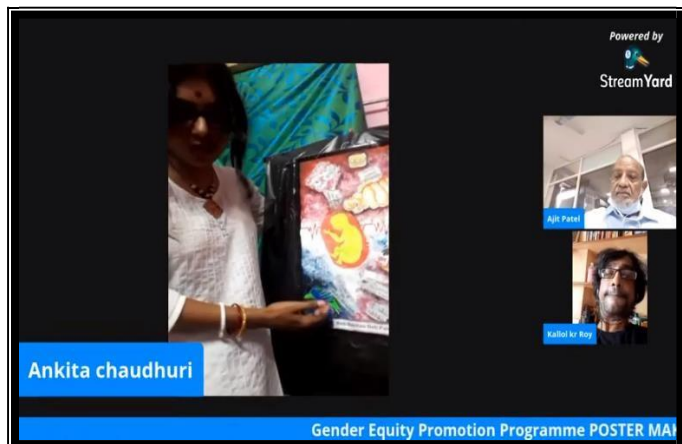
Ajit Patel's views over the Online programme: JUDGE of the Program

Glimpses of the Day's Activity

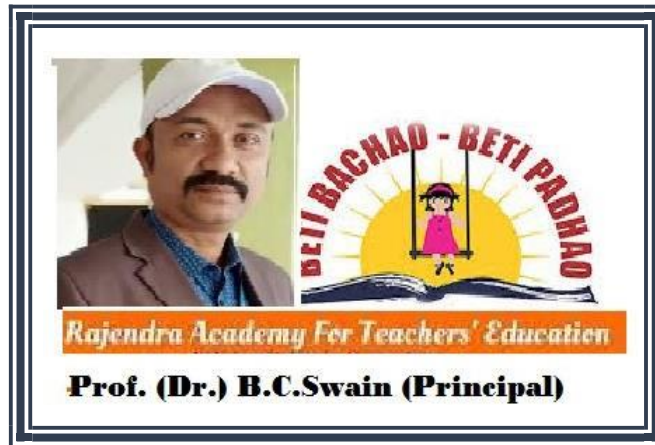

“Beti Bachao Beti Padhao Yojana” An Initiative for a better tomorrow

With the increased number of population, in every census there comes the real picture of the country's growth. The most remarkable thing which has been noticed in the existing scenario is that even if the country has grown multifold in relevance to the past years there still exists a scope of big correction in the ratio of number of girls standing strong in the number of boys.



The strength of a nation depends upon the strength of its natives. As the native works for his growth, the nation grows automatically with that effort. With the Initiative of “Beti Bachao, Beti Padhao” campaign the most highlighting factor was to make the nation aware of the current scenario of girl child present in India and the status of their education which may not only empower them if they continue their studies, but also be helpful in making them firm to tackle the difficulties of life which after being educated will be solved to some extent as per the eligibility they can outstand comparatively brighter and can take up the responsibility of family while spreading the wisdom and knowledge.

While noticing all these factors highly constructive coordinated and convergent efforts were needed to ensure the safe survival, highly protected environment for empowering the girl child to have a bright future, aiming to bring a great change with the initiative of “Beti Bachao Beti Padhao” drive. With the objective to make the nation more learned, educated and strong in the long run of life.

As per the 2001 census of India, the sex ratio of children aged 0-6 was 927 girls per 1000 boys which was reduced to only 918 girls per 1,000 boys in 2011. According to UNICEF statistics, India was ranked 41 among 195 countries in this regard in 2012. The aims and objectives of Beti Bachao Beti Padhao scheme. The complete aim of Beti Bachao Beti Padhao scheme is to celebrate the birth of a girl child to prevent the violation of the interests of girls as a result of outdated and conservative thoughts.

BBBP is run in favour of women and focuses on the empowerment and development of women. The diminishing ratio of girls in the Child Sex Ratio (CSR) is the major pointer of women disempowerment. CSR includes both, pre-birth inequality marked through gender preferred sex selection and post birth inequality against girl child. Social discrimination against girls and easy affordability and misuse of the diagnostic equipments have resulted greatly into female child foeticide and ultimately decreasing the ratio of girls in CSR.
